Access Is Denied Error 5 Free Space LeftIf System Restore doesnt display any restore points to choose from, make sure you have system protection turned on and that you have at least 300 MB of free space left on your hard disk if it is 500 MB or larger, or have at least 50 MB of free space if your hard disk is smaller than 300 MB.. If you have backups of your files, you can restore the files from a backup Access Is Denied Error 5 Free Space LeftThe descriptions of the restore points that are created automatically correspond with the name of an event, such as Windows Update installing an update.. System Restore returns your computer to the state that it was in before the restore point that you chose.

System Restore does not affect personal files, such as e-mail, documents, or photos, so it cannot help you restore a deleted file.. If System Restore doesnt fix the problem, you can also try an advanced recovery method.. In the search box, type System Restore, and then, in the list of results, click System Restore.. This may happen if the MpsSvc account doesnt have the necessary permissions for the related registry keys.
